Communication between school and home

Starting the Nursery Day on Time:

Nursery School starts at 8.30am and 12.30pm every day.

Phonics is taught at the start of the Nursery sessions every day. Phonics is an essential part of our reading curriculum and children at this time are learning the many skills they will need to be fluent readers and confident writers in the future.

Please try start the Nursery day on time so that children don't miss their phonics lessons.

Collecting Children from Nursery: If someone different is collecting your child from Nursery, even if they have been given the password, please can you call the school office to let us know.

Names on Clothing: Lots of children have similar clothing or uniform which unfortunately can get mixed up or lost. Please write your child's name on all clothing and footwear that your child brings to Nursery so that we can return this to you at the end of the day.

Library

All children will need a 'Green Nursery Book Bag' which should be brought to school every day. This will be used to send home letters and pictures and will also keep a library book safe. Library books will be changed in Nursery School every week by your child's key worker. Further information about our reading competitions and the day your child will be changing their library book will be sent home to you soon. Books bags can be purchased from the school office for £5.50

Spare Clothes: Nursery can be a messy place! Please make sure your child has a spare change of clothes, including underwear and socks, on their coat peg at all times (bags are provided for all the children).



Staffing Changes: There have been some changes to the staffing in Nursery this term. Breakfast Club will be led by Leah and Sam. After School Club will be led by Leah and our new TA Apprentice, Caitlin who will be completing her training with us. Caitlin will also be working with the children every afternoon in Nursery School.


Teaching and TA students will be supporting the children throughout the year.
