Each half-term this year we will be sending home a challenge to complete at home. If you complete the challenge, then email your child's Key Worker to let nursery know and we will send a certificate home for your child. This half term, the challenge is to 'Learn to do Things for Themselves'. This can be anything that you think they need to learn. It can include, toilet training, putting their coats on by themselves, tidying their toys or getting dressed for Nursery. Voluntary Termly Contributions

The children's Nursery Education is funded by the Government but this does not include money to provide the children with a **present at Christmas and Easter, some additional visitors to school, parties and treats**. To be able to fund this we have a school fund which we ask all parents to contribute to. We ask for a contribution of £10 per term, per child which will be collected this term through our Parent Pay system. I would like to thank you in advance for all of the contributions you make.

There is information about open days in many different schools on the noticeboard on the Nursery Driveway / Path.

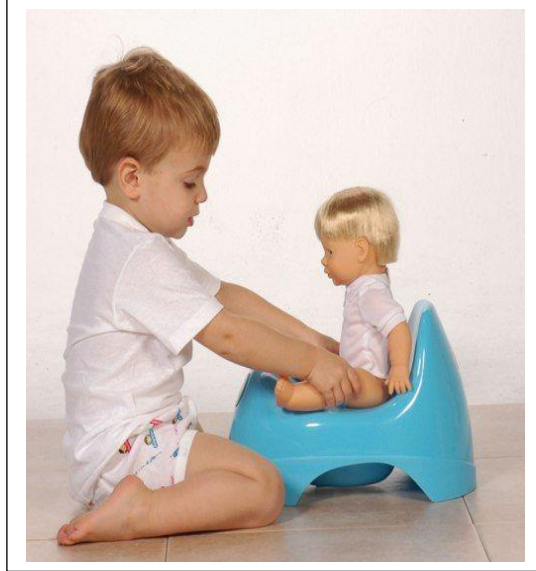
Library

All children will need a 'Green Nursery Book Bag' which should be brought to school every day. This will be used to send home letters and pictures and will also keep a library book safe. Library books will be changed in Nursery School every week by your child's key worker. Books bags can be purchased from the school office for £5.50



Toilet Training

If you have not already done so and you think your child is ready, the half-term holiday might be the right time to start to toilet train your child. When the children return to school after the holiday, the Nursery School can then support your child to continue to learn to use the toilet independently. We have information to help with toilet training in school. Please email or ask if you would like a copy of the information sending to you.

Names on clothing: Lots of children have similar clothing or uniform which unfortunately can get mixed up or lost. Please write your child's name on all clothing and footwear that your child brings to Nursery so that we can return this to you at the end of the day.



Nappies and wipes:

If your child needs nappies and wipes they should be provided from home. Staff will let you know if more nappies or wipes are needed. If Nursery nappies are used, then a charge will be made to your parent pay account.

Breakfast, Lunch and After School Clubs: Nursery School is open from 7.30am – 5.30pm so if you need your child to stay for additional hours then please ask. A price list is available on the school website.



From Monday 3rd October – Thursday 13th October: Parent meetings will be held in Nursery School. Please ask if you have not received an appointment time.

Half –term Holiday – School closes on Wednesday 19th October and Re-opens on Monday 31st October.
