Communication between school and home

All the children will have very busy and fun days at Nursery School but they might not always tell you what they have been doing when they get home! We have different ways to help with this in Nursery School such as our website, Facebook, text messages and emails.

If you ever have any concerns, please do not hesitate to email your child's key worker or telephone the school. We are looking forward to seeing you at our 'Stay and Play' events again this term and also inviting you into school for a Parents Meeting before the May half-term holiday. More information about these events will be sent home soon. Copies of your child's observations and learning stories will be sent home before the Summer holiday and children who are leaving school in July will bring their Learning Journey files home so that they can remember their time at Nursery School in the future.

We send home many messages via text throughout the year so if you change your telephone number, please tell the school office.

Names on clothing: Please make sure your child has a spare change of clothes on their coat peg at all times with at least one full set of spare clothes. Please write your child's name on all the clothing and footwear that your child brings to Nursery so that we can return this to you at the end of the day.
