## Starting the Nursery Day on Time:

Phonics is an essential part of our reading curriculum and children at this time they are learning the many skills they will need to be fluent readers and confident writers in the future.

Please try to ensure your child is in Nursery, on time, every day so that we can help them to learn many skills that will help them when they start Primary School.

## Children's Learning

The Nursery Staff plan the children's learning around 'Core Books'. The book is changed every two weeks and further information about the Core Story and some of the different learning that is planned for the children is always available on the noticeboard on the Nursery path.
